Re: Outcomes of Statutory Assessment in 2024

We are writing to you regarding the outcomes of statutory assessment in 2024.

We are very pleased to see attainment for your first Y6 cohort which is above the national average in reading and maths; in line with average in writing and GPaS.

Attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths Combined at the EXS was 76% which is 15% above the national average. These outcomes mean that a high proportion of pupils leave St John Henry Newman Catholic Primary School well prepared for the next stage of their education. This is very good achievement for the pupils and one which we are sure gives you and your staff a justifiable sense of pride.

The outcomes in 2024 provide good evidence of the quality of pupils' learning and progress in the school and the effectiveness of leadership and management in securing improvement.
