In our recent RE lessons, we explored Jesus' second and third miracles and reflected on their deeper meaning. We began by learning about Jesus healing the official's son, focusing on the importance of faith and trust. The children discussed how the official must have felt when Jesus healed his son without even being present, and what this miracle showed about belief and obedience. We then studied Jesus healing the paralysed man at the Pool of Bethesda. This miracle prompted thoughtful discussion about compassion, patience and the power of Jesus' words to transform lives. As part of our learning, the children took part in interview-style activities where they considered the reactions and emotions of both Jesus and the officers involved in these events. Using these insights, they then wrote letters to Jesus from the perspective of the officers, reflecting on how witnessing these miracles challenged their understanding and strengthened their faith.
